



Damaged Property Deduction

For most homeowners, their property is their most important asset. So when disaster strikes, and that property is damaged, the loss can be devastating.

You should not be stuck paying a full tax bill on a property that has been damaged or completely destroyed.

Fortunately, the **Damaged Property Deduction** may offer you substantial tax relief to help you recover.

Through this program, county auditors have the authority under Ohio law to reduce taxable values for properties that have been damaged or destroyed.

This is a statewide program, so if you live outside Montgomery County, you may still be eligible! Please contact your county auditor's office to apply.

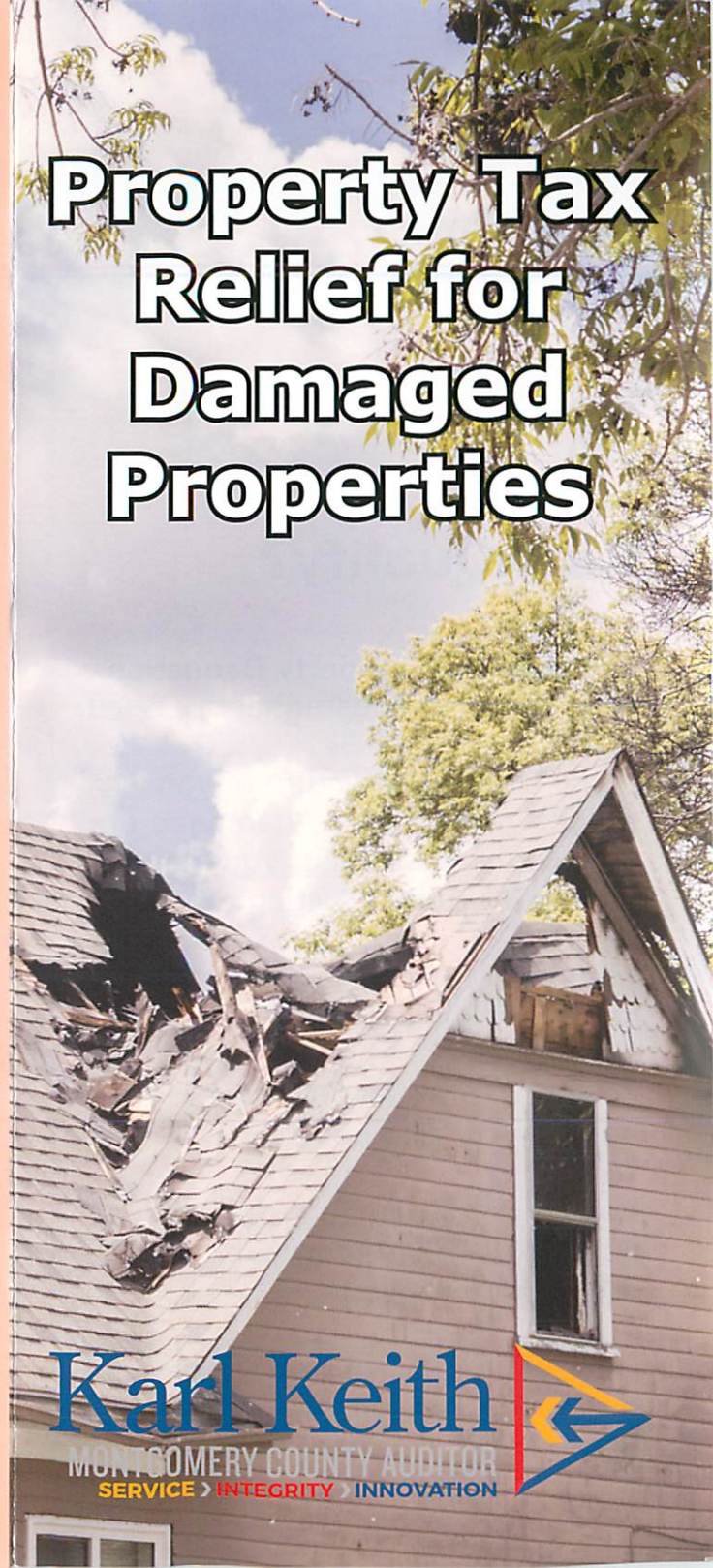
